

BCCWID Highway Boring Project

During early September of 2013 construction began on a second line to service East Side Water Customers. During the February 2013 BCCWID Board Meeting Management suggested boring a line replacement under the freeway, noting the current line was installed in the 60's. If that line failed, there would be a lengthy loss of service while a temporary line was installed. The cost estimate was \$80,000.00 and the Board unanimously approved seeking bids. In April Mitch Coury, representing Dolina Construction, Inc., was the lowest of three bidders at \$73,400.00 and the Board accepted the bid. The start of the work was delayed because of permitting problems with the County but is expected to be completed quickly with no loss of customer service.
